0:10	1965		Peter was a president of the Greek community. He tells the story from the beginning. In 1965 the church was just beginning. Peter was part of the choir. He was a chanter for 4-5 years, until the 70's.
0:45			The first priest picked Peter up every Sunday morning for the choir.
1:10			Peter attended Greek School later on. Maria Karkoulis was the Greek School teacher at that point. After her, Mr. Jerry Sakell took over and introduced a Greek dancing group. Peter remembers wearing a foustanella (traditional Greek skirt). He had fun.
2:06			Later he was involved as a member of the church council. In the 90s there were some problems in the community and Peter got together with other people from Kingston and helped solve all of these problems with lawsuits, etc. They finished the hall in the back. After this he again became a church council member, and now he just helps the community when he can.
